## Project Progress Update

### Stringfellow Statue Reinstatement

As part of the Chard Town Centre Public Realm Improvement Scheme, the Stringfellow Statue was removed and held in storage whilst works took place. The statue is currently undergoing refurbishment and repair prior to its reinstatement to its original position. A plinth has been created for its return and the statue will be reinstated shortly once refurbishment and repairs are complete.
